Dear Ms. Rose:

This letter responds to your letter received on February 1, 2024, and your email received on March 25, 2024, requesting an advisory opinion on behalf of PoliticalMeetings.com, LLC. The purpose of this letter is to inform you that the Commission has concluded its consideration of your advisory opinion request without issuing an advisory opinion.

The Commission publicly released three draft advisory opinions in response to your request. The drafts were identified as Draft A, Agenda Document No. 24-12-A (released on March 20, 2024), Revised Draft A, Agenda Document No. 24-12-A1 (released on April 11, 2024), and Draft B, Agenda Document No. 24-12-B (released on April 11, 2024). These agenda documents are available on the Commission's website, at [www.fec.gov/meetings/](http://www.fec.gov/meetings/).

At its Open Meetings of March 27, and April 18, 2024, the Commission held over the consideration of this matter. At its Open Meeting on May 1, 2024, the Commission considered but did not approve any of the draft advisory opinions. The Commission voted 3-3 on Revised Draft A and on Draft B. The Federal Election Campaign Act requires an affirmative vote of four members of the Commission to render an advisory opinion. *See* 52 U.S.C §§ 30106(c), 30107(a)(7); see also 11 C.F.R. § 112.4(a). Thus, the Commission was unable to render an advisory opinion in response to your request.
